

## Poster Presenter Instructions

The poster board will be portrait- **2 metres high by 1 metre wide.**

The Poster Exhibition will be split between the **Pentland Foyer** and the **Cromdale Hall** of the EICC.

Posters **MUST** be displayed from 9 a.m. on 6 December and should **NOT** be removed prior to 15.00 on 8 December. If this is not feasible, arrangements can be made to bring your poster back to the BMUS office if necessary.

Poster judging will commence the morning of 6<sup>th</sup> December.

All posters must be attached with **Velcro, which you should bring with you.**

It is essential that patient anonymity is maintained for all posters submitted. No poster should have any patient information i.e. name, date, hospital identity number, displayed either in the text or on images.

**Poster Prizes** will be presented in the Closing Ceremony on Tuesday 8 December.

**Poster presenters must register for the Meeting.** A discount is given for registration of all first named poster presenters.

**Abstracts** The abstract of your poster will be printed in 'Ultrasound,' the BMUS journal, published by the Royal Society of Medicine in February. It will also be published in the Abstract Book, available at Euroson.
