



BMUS Course Endorsement Policy

These guidelines are for anyone who wishes to have their course or study day endorsed by the British Medical Ultrasound Society. Please note; this process only confers BMUS *endorsement* for the course, i.e. our understanding that it is of a suitable content, being delivered appropriately. It does not confer any sort of accreditation, competency or CPD.

1. Each course submitted for endorsement will be put to the entire BMUS Scientific & Education Committee for consensus.
2. In order to endorse a course the following information is required:
 - Faculty
 - Faculty qualifications
 - Location of course
 - Target group(s)
 - Whether the course is theoretical or involves live scanning

All information should be sent to rachel@bmus.org

3. If the course involves live scanning, they must comply with the BMUS Live Scanning statement on the BMUS website. The course organizer should submit a statement saying they comply with these terms.
4. **Charges:**
 - £150 for non-commercial courses
 - £300 for commercial courses

5. BMUS will check sample materials and advise the course organizer on use of the BMUS logo and name.
6. BMUS will ensure that promotional materials are sent to any course we endorse.
