Ultrasound Training Day

The Hull Head and Neck Ultrasound Course - with practical hands-on scanning experience. To be delivered by a dedicated team of established Sonographers and Radiologists in the field of Head and Neck ultrasound in conjunction with the British Medical Ultrasound Society.

This course will outline the uses of Ultrasound in the head and neck by a series of practical live demonstrations and multiple “hands-on sessions”.

The programme starts with a live demonstration of the relevant anatomy using models. The key structures that act as landmarks within the neck will be highlighted. A systematic examination technique will be demonstrated, including the opportunity to scan live models following the techniques outlined working in small 7 sweeps technique. Delegates will then have the groups with an experienced H& N expert.

Each delegate will be sent a link for an online e-learning package a few weeks prior to the course. This will contain a series of lectures covering the major constituents of the neck and their associated pathology.

Programme:

09.00 - 09.30 Coffee and Registration

09.30 - 09.45 Welcome and Introduction

Morning session: 10.00 - 13.00

The morning session will start with a live demonstration of the relevant anatomy using a live model. The key structures that act as landmarks within the neck will be highlighted and a systematic examination technique will be demonstrated. This will incorporate the 7 sweeps of the neck technique and the Thyroid.

At relevant points during this session the delegates will break out into small groups with a member of the faculty and have the opportunity to scan live models gaining experience in the techniques outlined.

13.00 - 14.00 Lunch

Afternoon session: 14.00 - 16.15

The delegates working in small groups will practice the scanning techniques demonstrated, with opportunity to reinforce the technique and the ultrasound appearances.

16.15 - 16.30 Evaluation and close

Tea and coffee will be available during the morning & afternoon sessions.
