# Head & Neck Integrated Training

*Organised by R Evans*

**10th Dec 2015**

A full day of Head & Neck training following the same successful format as in previous years workshops. The anatomy of the head and neck will be taught in small (max. 5 delegates/tutor/US machine) groups in the morning practical session. Each area will be taught through a series of standard sweeps through the neck, devised and led by Dr Rhys, each area being initially demonstrated by live scanning by Dr. Evans. Following each demonstration the delegates will then scan the models under the supervision of a member of the faculty in their respective groups.

The neck will be systematically covered outlining the key structures that need to be identified, starting from the submental triangle and ending with the larynx. Tips and pitfalls will be highlighted allowing a comprehensive scanning technique of the neck to be mastered under the guidance of the faculty. The sweeps of the neck are contained in a pdf file that can be reviewed and downloaded with other files (which contain key lectures from previous BMUS integrated head and neck training days) that will be sent out electronically to all registered delegates 4 weeks prior to the conference.

**Salivary glands and larynx-revisited** - the key points that can be mastered in order to enable improved management of more complex head and neck cases are presented.

**Advanced techniques** - keynote lecture delivered by Prof Anil Ahuja on the latest advances in head and neck ultrasound. This lecture will be followed by an interactive session led by Dr Rhian Rhys on interaction of ultrasound with other modalities interventional techniques.
