

Standardising the DVT Report using ICE

1. **Title of scan**, including the **SIDE** at top of report (**BS20 AltX**).
2. **Clinical details**: COPY and PASTE all the clinical details and the EXTENDED clinical details from ICE into the RMS report before the body of the text, including the **D-Dimer**

*NB. the extended clinical details are: all the questions and answers from ICE including:- if from the **DVT Clinic, the Wells Score and D-Dimer**.*

3. Body of report (**BS2, BS3, BS4, BS5 Alt X**) or your own short codes/report.

4. **If positive DVT** – use **RED FLAG** (**BS19AltX**):

Please **conclude** all reports with the side and extent of the DVT in a manner that indicates if the DVT is limited to the calf or affects the proximal deep veins.

eg. Ilio-femoral, fem-pop, popliteal or calf DVT confirmed (UKAS guidelines).

5. Use **DVT AltX** fast code for all **POSITIVE DVT's**

POSITIVE DVT: If the patient has had recent surgery or in-patient DISCHARGE within the last 90 days - please copy these results to the patients Consultant/Surgeon and the VTE Committee for Root Cause Analysis.

If the scan is indeterminate or undiagnostic for any reason please state. If the scan is normal or negative for DVT then make this clear.

6. ALL POSITIVE DVTS SHOULD THEN BE INSERTED ELECTRONICALLY INTO THE NEW DVT MDTM
